The philosophy of Maîtres du Temps is portrayed in the logo by a tree, of which every branch is symbolic of a new project and new opportunities to have the great masters of the watchmaking world to work together. The first three talents to join forces successfully are Christophe Claret, Roger Dubuis and Peter Speake-Marin. Claret is a highly praised watchmaker who has made calibre movements for important brands such as Jean Dunand, deGrisogono, Harry Winston and Guy Ellia. Watchmaker Roger Dubuis began his career at Patek Philippe and later introduced his own brand in collaboration with Franck Muller and designer Carlos Dias. Finally Peter Speake-Marin is an independent watchmaker who has worked with such legendary teams as Renaud and Papi.

The first result of this exceptional initiative was appropriately named the **Chapter One (price on request)**. This versatile watch comes with a selection of complications, such as a tourbillon, chronograph, retrograde date display and retrograde second time zone. The day and moon phase, strikingly enough, are displayed using two rollers on the top and bottom of the case. The specially designed SHC02 calibre movement consists of 558 parts and fits into a case

of just 62.6 by 45.9 millimetres. The date, day, moon phase and second time zone can be adjusted with the four buttons on either side of the sturdy gold case and the chronograph is operated with the button integrated into the crown. The watch is produced in a limited edition run of four times eleven pieces in white or rose gold and with a silver or black dial.
