Patently enamored with his signature jacket, jeans and shirt, **Karl Lagerfeld** has taken fashion's notion of a capsule wardrobe—the embodiment of pared-down luxury—and applied it to fragrance. Kapsule, available starting in November exclusively at **Neiman Marcus**, comes in three scents—Woody, Floriental and Light (*above*; \$110 each)—to be worn separately or in layers.

Le Grand Frisson

In Sanskrit, the word *diamond* means “love at first sight,” which is why French jeweler **Chaumet** chose the translation as the title of its new fine-jewelry collection. Among the 30 pieces are gems such as spessartite garnets and rubellite tourmalines in combinations that leave no shortage of sparks flying.



Mondrian

Smythson, the British stationer known for smart leather notebooks and diaries, has introduced a collection of accessories inspired by the Dutch artist Piet Mondrian. The centerpiece of the line is a deluxe watch cabinet, but smaller items like the **Slim Travel Wallet** (*above*; \$550) are every bit as noteworthy.



Kate Somerville

With its secluded bungalows, Melrose Place address and Hollywood Hills views, the medi-skin spa **Kate Somerville Skin Health Experts** is as glamorous as its clientele, which includes Annette Bening and the Dixie Chicks. The spa recently opened its Hunter Barnes–designed penthouse (*above*) and in December debuts a luxury size of its Deep Tissue Repair cream (\$500).

Maitres du Temps

Luxury-watch distributor **Steven Holtzman** is taking timepieces to a new dimension. His inaugural brand, literally “masters of time,” unites 12 or so of the best craftsmen to collaborate on a single watch. The debut, a tourbillon, is **Chapter One** (*below*; \$400,000).
