Mâîtres du Temps

Three revered master watchmakers—Roger Dubuis, Christophe Claret, and Peter Speake-Marin—joined forces to create Mâîtres du Temps' Chapter One, the debut model of a rising-star collection that is the brainchild of industry veteran Steven Holtzman. Limited to 33 pieces, the mammoth watch combines a tourbillon with a mono-pusher chronograph, a retrograde date display, a retrograde GMT display, and two unusual rolling bars to indicate day of the week and moon phase.
